## Are Library Fines Keeping You Away?

### Read-it-Off Today!

If you are 15 years of age or younger with a Dacono Library fine, here is an easy way to “pay back” the Library. The Dacono Library is excited to introduce, “Read-it-Off”. During the month of February, every hour spent reading at the Library will reduce the outstanding fine by \$1. The Read-it-Off program is intended to help children and young adults reduce their outstanding fees so they can continue to use their library card without interruption. There is no limit on how long you can read and no restrictions on what you can read. Follow these 5 easy steps:

1. **Visit** the Dacono Library and bring all of your overdue items back to the Library today!
2. **Sign Up** at the Dacono Library for a reading log
3. **Read!** Erase \$1 in fines for roughly every 1 hour you read. All reading must be done at the Library.
4. **Log** your book titles and the hours and minutes you spend reading.
5. **Erase** your fines. The Librarian will confirm that you have met your goal, and all your outstanding Dacono Library fines will be erased!

## Glen Dale Circle Rehab Project Underway

### Council Approves Engineering Contract

Engineering design work on the Glen Dale Circle rehabilitation project will begin this month. The project includes repairs to 4,000 feet of curb, sidewalk, gutter and roadway along Glen Dale Circle from Glen Creighton Drive to Mac Laughlin Court. Additionally, 1,500 feet of 10" cement waterline, water service lines, and meter pits will also be repaired/replaced along Glen Dale Circle from Glen Creighton Drive to Mac James Court. This project was approved as part of the 2014 Capital Improvement Plan. The design and construction is budgeted over a two-year period.

## City Board and Commission Openings

### Deadline to Apply is February 17th

You can become active in the community by serving on a volunteer board or commission.

**What Boards & Commission have openings?** The following boards and commission have openings: Personnel Board (1 opening), Board of Adjustments (1 opening), Liquor Authority (2 openings; one regular & one alternate) and Police Advisory Committee (1 opening).

**What kind of training is required?** Most boards do not require any technical expertise to volunteer- just a desire to be active and get involved with your community. Many volunteer positions include an orientation for new members.

**Are there specific requirements to apply?** Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and have lived in the City of Dacono for a period of at least 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of appointment.

**What is time commitment required?** Most boards meet as necessary or at least once a year. Some boards, such as the Planning & Zoning Commission, have a regular monthly meeting schedule. Additionally,

most boards meet in the evening. If there is a specific board that interests you, contact the City Clerk to get more information.

Applications will be accepted until 5:00pm on Monday, February 17, 2014.

**When will appointments to boards and commission be made?** If needed, the City Council will hold schedule appointments to meet with interested candidates. The next set of meetings is Monday, February 24, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Candidates will be appointed that evening during the City Council meeting. You don't have to attend the City Council meeting to be appointed.
