Almost Free Building Permit Month Begins in June!



It's time to head to the home improvement store and kick-off that summer project. Don't forget that during the month of June, the City of Dacono is offering "Almost Free Building Permits". In an effort to encourage residents of Dacono to upgrade and improve their residential properties, the City Council will temporarily reduce the amount of certain fees associated with issuing residential building permits during the entire month of June. This includes application fees, plan review and inspection fees. The fee reduction applies towards the alteration, repair or improvement of existing residential structures and the erection, alteration, repair or improvement of structures associated with existing homes, such as garages, additions, carports, sheds and fences. Payment of use tax still applies. All necessary permits must be obtained prior to beginning your project. As always, any work completed without a building permit is subject to double permit fees. Work authorized under the permit must be completed by no later than September 30, 2014, otherwise all applicable fees, including the full building permit fee and plan review fees and inspection fees, shall be paid. Summit Boulevard Reconstruction

City to Seek Alternate Bid Proposals

Construction of an improved Summit Blvd. is on hold. Bids for the water line, drainage and asphalt work were due on April 21 and two bids were received. The bid amounts exceeded the projected budget by more than \$450,000. As a result, the City will look at dividing the work into smaller projects and/or phasing the project over a longer period of time. The work generally consists of construction of approximately 1 mile of roadway between York Street and Colorado Boulevard including the lowering of approximately 300’ of 18” water transmission line. The project is funded by the City’s capital improvement budget and transportation impact fees from new development.



Property Maintenance Reminders

Being a good neighbor and keeping our neighborhoods clean are goals, which all Dacono residents should strive to achieve. While most people recognize the value of being a good neighbor, there are a number of neighborly practices, which everyone should keep in mind. There are some of the essential building blocks necessary for a clean and healthy neighborhood:

- ◆ Don’t park cars on your front lawn. Aside from giving your home and neighborhood an unsightly appearance, lawn parking is a violation of the Dacono Municipal Code. Do help maintain the appearance of your neighborhood by parking either on the street or in your driveway.
- ◆ Don’t leave trash cans at the curb after your trash is picked up. Also avoid the accumulation of trash, litter and debris from occurring. Leaving trash cans at the curbside for an extended period creates an impression of an untidy neighborhood and also contributes to health and sanitation problems by attracting flies and other pests.
- ◆ Keep your lawn, trees, and shrubbery well watered and neatly trimmed. Since the appearance of our homes and lawns speaks to the pride of ownership in the Dacono community, diligent property maintenance of lawns and associated landscaping will increase property values as you do your part to beautify our community.

Adherence to local ordinances, together with cooperation and a little common sense form the basic ingredients for a happy and healthy neighborhood. Dacono Code Enforcement will be aggressively addressing code violations this spring. Take pride in Dacono.
