City of Dacono to Begin Sales Tax Self-Collection July 1

Effective July 1, 2015 the City of Dacono will begin collecting the 3% local sales tax directly from businesses. The City of Dacono is a Home Rule municipality under Article XX of the Colorado Constitution, and has the power to collect its own taxes locally and not through the Colorado Department of Revenue.

Self-collection has been enacted in order to enable the City to more efficiently and accurately process our portion of the sales tax. With the sales tax collection being handled by the State, the City is limited in its knowledge of the details and therefore in its enforcement of audits and collections. In addition, self-collection of sales tax makes funds readily available for City use. The majority of home-rule cities in Colorado collect their sales tax directly as opposed to utilizing the services of the State of Colorado.

Businesses collecting local sales tax should not send the City of Dacono 3% sales tax to the State of Colorado for any transaction conducted after June 30, 2015. Additionally, all persons engaged in the operation, conduct, or carrying on of any trade, profession, business, or occupation within the City, whereby the collection and remittance of sales or use tax is obligatory, should purchase a City sales and use tax license. This includes rentals, leases, deliveries or shipments into the City. The City of Dacono will host two informational meetings for businesses required to collect and remit sales tax.

Citywide Clean-Out Day– Saturday, May 16

The annual citywide clean-out day is scheduled for Saturday, May 16 at the Front Range Landfill, 1830 Weld County Road 5, in Erie. **The program has changed for 2015.** Dacono residents, with valid ID, can obtain one voucher from Dacono City Hall for free disposal of one load of large bulk items. This voucher must be obtained at Dacono City Hall between Friday, May 1 and Friday, May 15 by 12:00 p.m. The City will offer extended evening hours to obtain a voucher on Monday, May 11 until 6:00 p.m. Only one voucher per household will be issued. On Saturday, May 16 *only* residents can take their load of large, bulk items to the landfill during normal business hours. The voucher must be presented to the gate attendant or landfill charges will apply. Residents 65 years of age or older or those with a disability, can contact Dacono City Hall and request assistance with their bulk waste disposal. Contact Mandy Ross at (303) 833-2317 ext. 121. Clean-Out Day Tips

- ◆ Residents **must** obtain a voucher from City Hall— no vouchers issued at the landfill.
- ◆ Residents can dispose of bulk waste items free of charge with **voucher only** on Saturday, May 16.

Almost Free Building Permit Month Begins in June!

It's time to head to the home improvement store and kick-off that summer project. Don't forget that during the month of June, the City of Dacono is offering "Almost Free Building Permits". In an effort to encourage residents of Dacono to upgrade and improve their residential properties, the City Council will temporarily reduce the amount of certain fees associated with issuing residential building permits during the entire month of June. This includes application fees, plan review, and inspection fees. The fee reduction applies towards the alteration, repair, or improvement of existing residential structures and the erection, alteration, repair or improvement of structures associated with existing homes, such as garages, additions, carports, sheds and fences. Payment of use tax still applies. All necessary permits must be obtained prior to beginning your project. As always, any work completed without a building permit is subject to double permit fees. Work authorized under the permit must be completed by no later than September 30, 2015, otherwise all applicable fees, including the full building permit fee and plan review fees and inspection fees, shall be paid. Glen Dale Circle Rehab Project Phase II– Summer 2015

The City of Dacono will complete phase II of the Glen Dale Circle water line rehabilitation project. Phase II includes Glen Dale Circle from Mac Leod Ct (north) to Glen Creighton Drive. The project consists of demolition and removal of approximately 7,810 SY asphalt and 3,560 LF of sidewalk, curb and gutter, as well as reconstruction of the water main consisting of 1085 LF of 8" PVC, 4 fire hydrants and 32 water service lines. Street improvements will consist of 1,616 tons of asphalt, 3,025 tons of aggregate base and reconstruction of 3,560 LF of curb, gutter and sidewalk. The bid opening is scheduled for May 6. The project is expected to start on June 1 and be completed by September 1, 2015.
