Mosquito Control

Call Mosquito Hotline to Report Problem Areas

The City contracts with Colorado Mosquito Control for its mosquito management program. Mosquito control will continue through the end of summer. The mosquito program includes surveillance/trap counts as well as traditional fogging. Colorado Mosquito Control employs two kinds of traps to monitor mosquito populations. The most commonly used is the CDC light trap which uses carbon-dioxide from dry ice as bait to attract female mosquitoes seeking a blood meal from a breathing animal. Once attracted by the CO₂, the mosquitoes are lured by a small light to a fan that pulls them into a net for collection. The gravid trap uses a tub of highly-organic water as bait to attract female mosquitoes that are looking for a place to lay their eggs. A fan placed close to the water surface forces mosquitoes that come to the water into a collection net. Once back in the laboratory, the contents of the trap nets are counted and identified by technicians trained to recognize the Colorado mosquito species. Business Licensing and Sales Tax

The City of Dacono began collecting its own sales tax effective with the July reporting period. The first sales tax returns are due on August 20, 2015. Anyone running a business in the City of Dacono is required to have a valid business license and submit a registration form for sales tax collection. Business licenses require an annual renewal; this includes home occupation businesses. Also, any business delivering tangible goods into the City should register for sale tax collection and charge sales tax on those goods. Any business with a valid sales tax registration is able to submit sales tax returns directly from the City of Dacono website. Go to www.cityofdacono.com, and select City Services, then select Sales Tax, and then follow the payment links. If you know your account number you will be able to login and create your returns, view account information, and even pay your return in one convenient location. Door-to-Door Solicitors & Contractors City License Required

Any door-to-door solicitor or contractor in the City of Dacono is required to first obtain a solicitor's license from the City Clerk. Residents are advised to ask any door-to-door salesperson to first show their current City of Dacono solicitor's license prior to engaging in any business transaction. Contractors are licensed in the City of Dacono and required to show proof of insurance. The City advises residents to be wary of door-to-door home improvement contractors and to confirm any contractor has a valid license. Electricians are not required to hold a contractor's license but should register with the City. Please report any unlicensed solicitors to the City of Dacono at (303)833-2317 during business hours or after hours call, (720) 652-4222, the non-emergency number for the Police Department.

Interested in City Council? Nomination Petitions Available August 4

This year Dacono voters will select two councilmembers and a Mayor on November 3. Residents interested in seeking election to the office of City Councilmember or Mayor can pick-up nomination petition packets beginning Tuesday, August 4, at 8:00 a.m. Petitions must be returned no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 24. Qualified candidates must have resided in the City of Dacono for at least 12 consecutive months, be 18 years of age, and a registered voter. EDAD to Conduct Condition Survey

The Economic Development Authority of Dacono (EDAD) authorized a condition survey at its July 13, 2015 meeting. Many residents in Dacono and property owners within the City's future growth area may receive notice by postcard that a conditions survey (blight study) is being conducted of select private and public parcels, as well as public improvements including rights of way. The purpose of the survey / study is to determine whether adverse conditions exist sufficient for the Economic Development Authority of Dacono to designate the area where the parcels and improvements exist as an urban renewal area, pursuant to the provisions of the Colorado Urban Renewal Law. Upon completion, copies of the final survey document will be available for inspection in the office of the City Clerk at 512 Cherry Street, Dacono, Colorado 80514.
